**7:30 pm Evening Service**

**Thursday, September 9th**

**Tashlich and Picnic** at Madrona

Park Picnic Shelter (853 Lake Washington Blvd). Tashlich is a brief ritual in which we

symbolically cast our past transgressions into the water with the hope that we will begin the new year cleansed. Please bring your own picnic food and blanket.

**Friday, September 17th**

**7:30 pm Kol Nidre**

We begin with the beautiful melody of Kol Nidre, and continue with prayers of forgiveness. It is customary to wear a tallit or prayer shawl at this service.

**Saturday, September 18th**

**9:30–10 am Children's Service**

Rabbi Zari and the Ensemble lead a special Yom Kippur service for children five years and younger.

**10:00 am-2:00 pm Childcare**

Childcare includes games, crafts, snacks and an enriching Jewish experience for children ages 1-9.

**10:30 am Morning Service**

We join in the traditional prayers for forgiveness.

**2-4 pm Study Sessions**

Two one-hour study sessions will be offered. Topics to be announced at Rosh Hashanah.

**Childcare 3:30-6:30 pm**

**4 pm Afternoon Services**

*Mincha, Yizkor and Neilah*

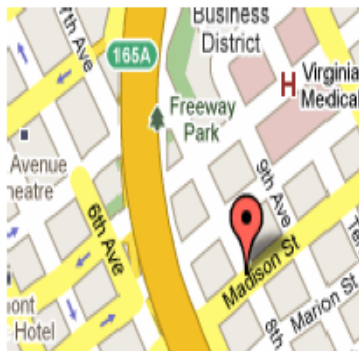
All are welcome to participate.

## Transportation

Being good stewards of the earth, *shomrei adamah*, is an essential Jewish value. Therefore, we encourage you to use public transportation. If you are using Link Light rail, the University Street station is four blocks away, while Metro bus lines 2, 12 and 13 all run near the Church.

If coming by car, please consider carpooling. There is no free parking at the Church. You may park in any of the nearby pay lots, including the one next to Town Hall across the street.

## **High Holy Days with Kol HaNeshamah: Frequently Asked Questions**

### **Is childcare available during High Holy Day services?**

Yes, childcare is available for children 1-9 years old. Pre-registration is preferred and there is a \$15 per child/per service fee. If you do not pre-register, the cost is \$30 per child/per service at the door **if space is available**. To reserve your spot(s), please fill out the childcare registration form in this brochure.

### **Are there any Tikkun Olam opportunities associated with KHN's services?**

Yes! Pick up an empty bag on Rosh HaShanah and return it full of food on Yom Kippur. Your food contribution will be donated to a local food bank.

### **Is there anything else I should know?**

In order to be courteous to those with allergies or who are fasting, please refrain from wearing strong scents or eating, drinking or chewing gum during services on Yom Kippur.
